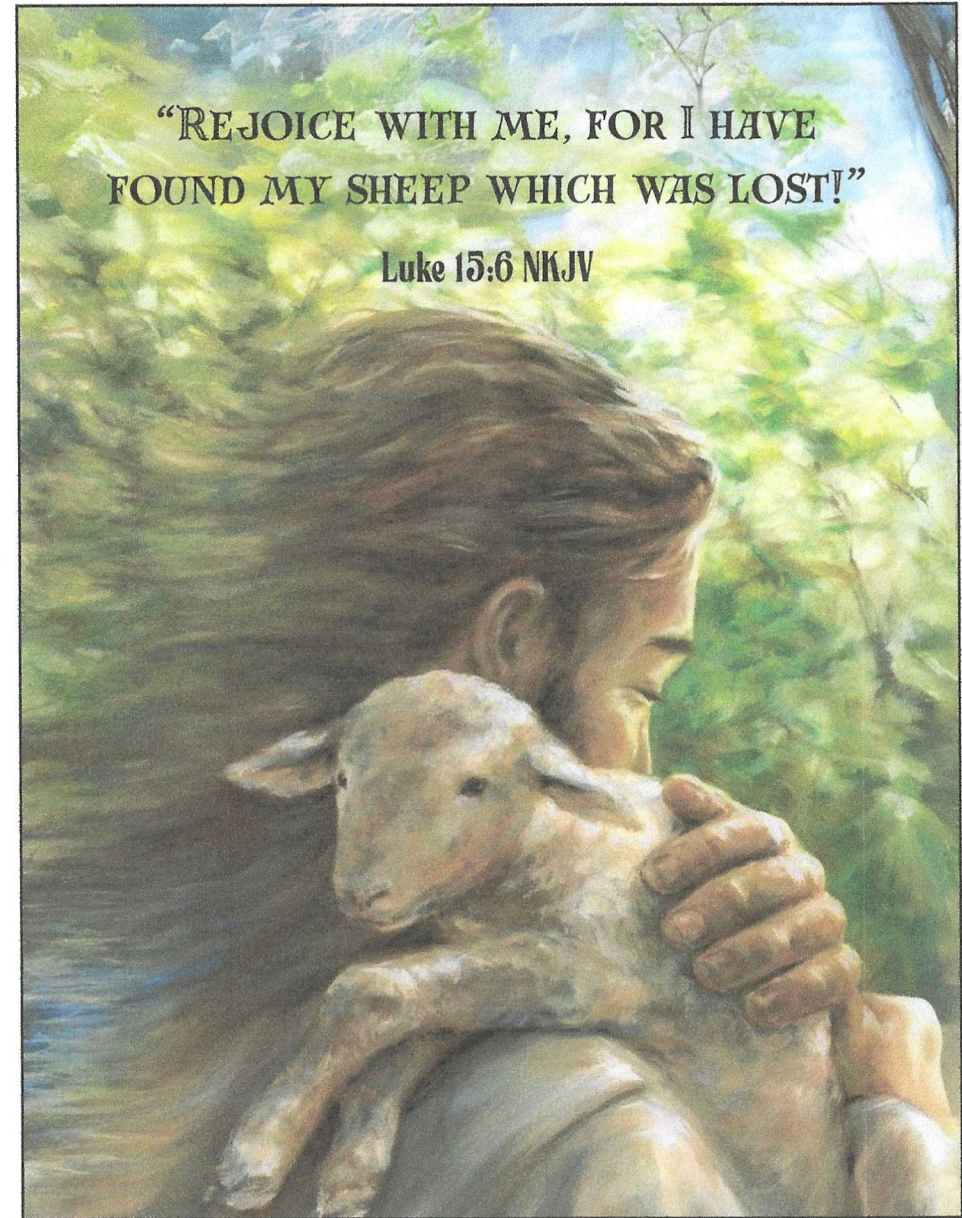

Asaph - Psalm 73:2-5 (CSB) ² *But as for me, my feet almost slipped; my steps nearly went astray.* ³ *For I envied the arrogant; I saw the prosperity of the wicked.* ⁴ *They have an easy time until they die, and their bodies are well fed.* ⁵ *They are not in trouble like others; they are not afflicted like most people.*

Jeremiah Jeremiah 12:1-2 (CSB) *You will be righteous, LORD, even if I bring a case against you. Yet, I wish to contend with you: Why does the way of the wicked prosper? Why do all the treacherous live at ease?* ² *You planted them, and they have taken root. They have grown and produced fruit. You are ever on their lips, but far from their conscience.*

Asaph (the Worship Leader) Psalm 73:16-17 (CSB) ¹⁶ *When I tried to understand all this, it seemed hopeless* ¹⁷ *until I entered God's sanctuary. Then I understood their destiny.*

Jeremiah Jeremiah 12:5 (CSB) - God's response - *If you have raced with runners and they have worn you out, how can you compete with horses? If you stumble in a peaceful land, what will you do in the thickets of the Jordan?*
